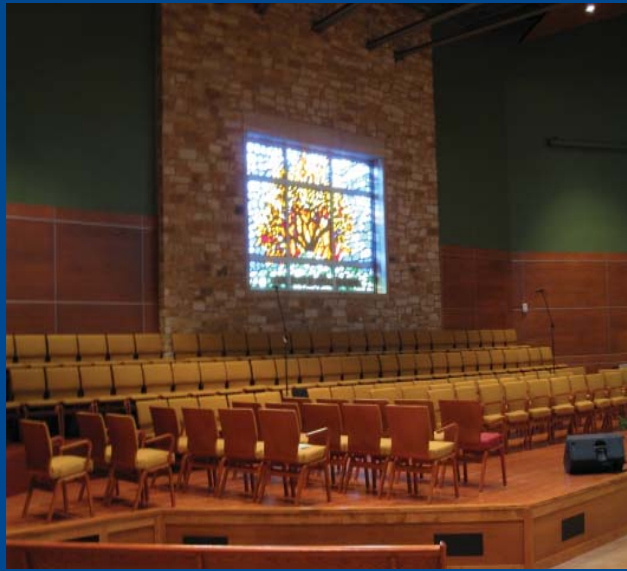

The Greater Mount Sinai Church of God in Christ was founded in 1961, in the basement of the home of the late Reverend Walter Davis and his wife. Since those humble beginnings, the congregation has grown and now serves more than 900 people each week. The church is an anchor of community energy and vitality within the distressed Silver Spring neighborhood of Milwaukee. The church's mission, in part, is to reach the community with a message of hope and to prepare their youth to be the leaders of tomorrow. Not only does the church provide a place of worship, but also offers necessary community services including counseling, youth programs, family and prison ministries, and two senior housing complexes.

Despite its growth and strong reputation, the church was turned down when it approached local banks for funding to expand its facilities. After one local bank backed out of a promised loan, Greater Mt. Sinai turned to local CDFI lending partners, Legacy Bank and Legacy Redevelopment Corporation, and PCG for help.

Our partnership provided a portion of the financing needed to expand the community building and renovate the church to expand capacity so they could continue to spread their message of hope in the community.



Renovation of the Greater Mt. Sinai church was recently completed and the new multi-purpose facility can now seat 1,300 people. According to Reverend Victor Davis, son of the church's founding pastor, the community takes great pride in their new church.
